UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS FOR THE 2007/2008 ACADEMIC YEAR

Applications are invited from suitably qualified Tanzanian and non Tanzanian candidates for admission into the following undergraduate degree programmes at the Muslim University of Morogoro (MUM) for the 2007/ 2008 academic year:

1. Bachelor of Arts (Education): – Duration 3 years (6 Semesters)
2. Bachelor of Arts (Mass Communication): – Duration 3 years (6 Semesters)
3. Bachelor of Islamic Studies with Education: – Duration 3 years (6 Semesters)

1.0 GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1.1 Minimum Entry Requirements

1.1.1 Direct Entry

The minimum entry requirements for the degree programmes under direct entry qualifications are:-

- (a) Certificate of Secondary School Education Examination (C.S.E.E.) or East African Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) or equivalent with credit passes in **THREE** approved subjects obtained prior to the sitting of the Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (A.C.S.E.E.) or East African Certificate of Education (Advanced Level) or equivalent;

and

- (b) one of the following combinations of passes in the A.C.S.E.E or equivalent:

either

- (i) a minimum of two principal level passes in appropriate subjects with total points of not less than 4.0 based on the following scale:

A = 5; B = 4; C = 3; D = 2; E = 1; S = 0.5

or

- (ii) an appropriate equivalent Diploma/Certificate of not less than Second Class/Credit level and approved by the University Senate.

For foreign applicants with Ordinary Certificate of Secondary Education Examination and who are from countries whose education systems are based on 8 years of primary school education, 4 years of secondary school education, and 4 years of University education, the minimum entrance requirements shall be as follows:

- (i) must have completed one year of study in a University in his/her own home country;

or

- (ii) have an appropriate equivalent Diploma/Certificate of not less than Second Class/Credit level and approved by the University Senate;

or

- (iii) have taken in Tanzania, the Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examinations, or equivalent;

or

- (iv) have baccalaureate certificate in approved subjects.

2.0 SPECIFIC ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The specific entry requirements for the different degree programmes are as follows:

2.1 Bachelor of Arts (Education)

2.1.1 Direct Entry Qualifications

- (i) A minimum of principal level passes in two teaching subjects (English, Kiswahili, Geography, History, Mathematics, Arabic and Islamic Knowledge), at the same sitting, with total points of not less than 4.0;

or

- (ii) an appropriate equivalent Diploma/Certificate of not less than Second Class/Credit level and approved by the University Senate.

2.2 Bachelor of Arts (Mass Communication)

2.2.1 Direct Entry Qualifications

- (i) A minimum of two principal level passes in arts or science subjects, at the same sitting, with total points of not less than 4.0:

and

should have credit passes in English and Kiswahili at C.S.E.E;

or

- (ii) an appropriate equivalent Diploma/Certificate of not less than Second class/Credit level and approved by the University Senate.

2.3 Bachelor of Islamic Studies with Education

2.3.1 Direct Entry Qualifications

- (i) A minimum of two principal level passes in appropriate subjects, at the same sitting, with total points of not less than 4.0;

and

should have a credit pass in Islamic Knowledge and Arabic Language at C.S.E.E;

or

obtained at least a Thanawiyah certificate or its equivalent from Islamic schools or colleges.

3.0 MATURE AGE ENTRY

This approach is to allow candidates who wish to study for a first-degree programme of the Muslim University of Morogoro, but unfortunately, do not possess the qualifications, which satisfy the University Direct Entry requirements. Thus, the University provides an alternative method of entry by way of Mature Age Entry Approach whose conditions are as follows:

- (i) Candidates must be 25 years of age or above, on October 1st of the year in which admission is sought.
- (ii) Candidates should have obtained at least 3 credit passes in approved subjects at O- level;
- (iii) The candidates should be able to show that they have been up-grading their existing knowledge by attending some form of classes/courses in which recommendation from the class tutor(s) will be necessary.

or

- (iv) Candidates who have attempted “A” Level Examination but failed to attain minimum points required for University Admission provided he/she has attended extra mural classes or a residential course after the “A” Level Examination.

3.1 Application for Admission

- 3.1.1. Candidates who meet Conditions (i) – (iv) of the Mature Age Entry Examination Scheme and wish to apply for admission to a degree course of the Muslim University of Morogoro should obtain application forms from the designated places or download them from specified Websites.
- 3.1.2. Prospective candidates of the Mature Age Entry Examination are required to submit dully completed application forms immediately to the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academic).

3.2 Examination Fee:

- 3.2.1 A non refundable fee Tz(shs) 30,000/= will be charged to cover both application and examination expenses.

3.3 Mode of Examination

- 3.3.1 The Mature Age Entry Examination of the Muslim University of Morogoro consists of two parts:

PART I: Tests the candidates' knowledge of English Language and Reasoning Ability. This part has three sections

SECTION I (VERBAL ABILITY): It tests the candidates' knowledge of Spoken English

SECTION II (NUMERICAL ABILITY): It tests the candidates' ability to think and reason numerically.

SECTION III (COMPREHENSION): It tests the candidates' ability to read and understand English Language.

PART II: Tests the candidates' knowledge in academic fields that they seek to study at the University.

- 3.3.2 **NOTE:** Candidates must pass both PART I and II of the examination. Candidates who have satisfied examiners in the Mature Age Entry Examination shall be considered for admission.

4.0 DATES OF EXAMINATIONS FOR BOTH DIRECT AND MATURE AGE ENTRY CANDIDATES

Mature age and Matriculation examinations – 5/5/2007

5.0 FEE STRUCTURE

Selected students shall be required to pay tuition and other University fees at the beginning of the first semester before they can be permitted to use University facilities. The fees for Tanzanian and foreign students are as follows:

6.0 Application Forms

- 6.1 Applicants are advised to obtain **Application Forms** from Admissions Office room number 7 Administration Block, MUM Campus, Morogoro.
- 6.2 Application forms may also be obtained from the office of Umoja wa Kiislam wa Elimu, Uchumi na Maendeleo (UKUEM), Zanzibar or can be downloaded from www.mdftz.org and www.mum.ac.tz

Applicants must:

- (i) Give full particulars of citizenship (including copy of birth certificate) and enclose photocopies of relevant academic certificates.
- (ii) Pay a non-refundable application and entrance examination fees of TAS 30,000/- for Tanzanians and USD 20 for foreigners. All fees must be paid directly to the **Bursar, Muslim University of Morogoro** or through Postal Order payable to the **Muslim University of Morogoro, P.O. Box 1031, Morogoro, Tanzania.**
- (iii) Downloaded application forms must be attached with photocopy of money order or bank slip for the TAS 30,000/= for application and examination fees. Full name and address of the applicant should also be indicated at the back of the photocopy. Unpaid for application forms shall not be processed.

Deadline for receiving application forms is 16:00 hours local time on **28th April 2007.**
