JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

This is important information for all selected students for Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences programs at the Muslim University of Morogoro [MUM]. This form **SHOULD NOT** be used as an official Admission Letter.

1. Registration and Orientation week

Registration and Orientation of new students will be held from 14th to 17th October, 2023 from 8.30 am to 04.00 pm. The venue will be **ICT Complex Block** for registration and **Assembly Hall** for Orientation.

2. Conditions for Admission:

You will have to meet the following conditions before being registered as a bonafide MUM Student.

A. Academic Credentials

i. For Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences

Students selected under this scheme must have at least **FOUR** passes at O'Level Examinations or its equivalent obtained from **NECTA** with atleast D grade in Physics or Mathematics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

ii. For Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences (Upgrading)

Students selected for Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences (Upgrading)must possess NTA Level 5 certificate in Medical Laboratory Sciences from NACTVET-recognized institution.

B. Necessary Attachments

Selected students are required to bring (1) Admission Letter, (2) Original and copy of Form Four certificate, (3) Original and copy of NTA 5 Certificate for Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences Upgrading, (4) Original and copy birth certificate, (5) One ream of paper and (6) Dully filled MUM Medical Examination Reports form from a registered Doctor (Copy of the Medical Form is available in our website for downloading).

C. Students' Conduct

i. General Conduct.

As a student of MUM you will be required to be diligent and exemplary at all times and observe Institutional Code of Conduct based on Islamic Moral values. Any antisocial behavior is not tolerated at the Muslim University of Morogoro. Please obtain your copy of Students' Code of Conduct through our website or the office of Dean of Students once you complete registration.

ii. Dress Code.

All students registered in this program should adhere to the uniform prescribed by the Ministry of Health as

follows:

Black shoes with flat heel, at least two pairs of white socks, and black belt for male(s).

(ii) Khaki trouser with white tops adhering to Islamic dress code (will be available at MUM per costs

indicated below).

NOTE: Wearing of tight, transparent or any anti-Islamic dresses are strictly prohibited for both men and

women.

D. University Fees.

All students should pay at least half of their semester fee before registration as indicated in the fee structure

below. All payments of tuition and Other Costs (Registration fee, Field/Practical Training fee, ID processing fee,

Students' union fee and TCU Quality assurance fee, etc) should be done through NMB Account.

bank.

4. Equipment for students' personal use:

Laptops [not desktop computers] for accessing study materials on the internet. Wireless internet is available

at MUM Campus for free, and there is a large corpus of electronic books online for everyone.

Students are **NOT ALLOWED** to come with: (i) T.V (ii) Radio/Radio Cassette (iii) Cooker, (iv) Electric heater.
